1. Girls Hockey

Re: Series

“That the OFSAA Girls Hockey championship be split such that the “A” and “AA” classifications are contested separately.”

Whereas Article IX: Finances, Section 1: Fees, item b) on page 13 of the NOSSA Constitution currently reads: "***The above fees shall be collected by the District Secretaries and one cheque for each district shall be forwarded to the Secretary-Treasurers by November 15th of the current year. Late fines shall be 10% up to November 30th. After November 30th an additional fine of \$5.00 per school day to a maximum of \$50.00 will be imposed***".

Rationale: The NOSSA transfer appeal process has been non-existent for at least four years now, and the transfer rule, as currently stated in the NOSSA constitution, is badly out of date. Removing the entire section more accurately reflects current practice.

Add: “If a championship banner is not awarded in any year, banners for that championship will not be ordered for the following year. If indeed the championship is hosted, it will be back ordered.”

N.O.S.S.A. PLAYING REGULATIONS - COED**1. Alpine Ski**

Reference: Entry, Item (b) – Boys/Girls

Revise to read: “No limit on the number of members allowed to race in each event, 3 to count. Members may include ...”

Rationale: To help encourage participation in a sport that has seen decline in recent years.

2. Alpine Ski

Reference: Entry, Item (b)

Delete the following: “Teams must notify the convener one week in advance in writing, by courier service, their intention to enter and confirm by phone. This is necessary, due to computer set-up time prior to the meet.”

Revise to read: “A racer can climb or continue if it does not interfere with next racer. Coaches responsibility to inform racers of rule and will be clarified at coaches meeting prior to race.”

That the NOSSA Track and Field schedule be amended to reflect the version included in Appendix "B". (Amendments: Open Girls PV should read Jr/Sr, on Thursday, Jr/Sr Girls PV should carry a 6pm start instead of 5pm and all OFSAA event numbers should be included.)"

- b) Middle distance events are spread out over the day and a half meet to allow athletes a better chance for success.

- e) The current schedule is grueling for many of the athletes and could use revamping

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Concern was expressed about an article written in Sudbury Star by NOSSA Acting Secretary regarding NOSSA Football Final. Feeling was that content was divisive and Sault coach should have been consulted beforehand.
2. Concern expressed with regard to timing of NOSSA Boys AAA Basketball finals. Playing regs call for 1pm Junior and 3pm Senior finals, but this year's finals took place much later than that.
3. North Shore is attempting to start up a rugby program with a view to hopefully participating at the OFSAA level at some time in the future. Reps were requested to bring this message back to their coaches in hopes that the activity may be started up in their areas.
4. Sudbury has started up a boys' slo-pitch event which is now in its fifth year. Convener has hopes to expand into baseball to participate in OFSAA Festival event at Rogers' Centre. Will keep rest of NOSSA informed as a league structure is required to advance to OFSAA event.

N.O.S.S.A. PLAYING REGULATIONS - GIRLS**1. Basketball**

Reference: Scheduled Format – “AAA” Championships

“Be it resolved that, The “AAA” Girls Basketball NOSSA Championship revert back to a single elimination tournament, with an effort to seed teams (1st vs 4th, 2nd vs 3rd) based on season performance.”

Rationale: Allows for students from visiting teams to return to home by 11pm on a school night.

4. **Volleyball**

Reference Add new section after Schedule entitled “Warm-Ups”

“Warm-ups will consist of a 5-5-5-1-1 format. Five (5) minutes will be a common time for on court warm-up; five (5) minutes for team serving first at net; five (5) minutes for team receiving first at net. One (1) minute serving warm-up for team serving first at net; One (1) minute serving warm-up for receiving team.”

Rationale: The five minutes will be used by individual teams to hit and work on their passing without interruption. The one-minute serving will be one team at a time.

3. Laura Aubertin (CGA Rep to OFSAA) wished all retiring coaches a happy and healthy retirement, with special wishes to Pat Belanger, a long-time contributor to NOSSA activities and the recipient of the 2007 Pete Beach Award.
