This housekeeping change would align current practice with the Eligibility Part C section of the Alpine playing regulations.

7. Wrestling – Reference: Weigh-Ins, Page 51

Reads presently:

Weigh-ins will take place the night prior to the NOSSA meet. The weigh-ins and skin checks will be the duration of one hour. If a school is located one hour away or more from the venue the coach may weigh in the wrestlers and fax or email the list of wrestlers (convener's choice) by 4 PM the day before the meet. If entries are emailed or faxed, fees must be paid on the entries submitted. Those who don't make weight on the morning of the meet will be disqualified.

Replace in its entirety and replace with the following:

Weigh-ins will take place the night prior to the NOSSA meet. All entries must be submitted to the Draw Master two days prior to the event. Weigh-ins and skin checks will be the duration of one hour, commencing at the predetermined start time.

If a school is located 100 km or less from the venue they may weigh in the morning off the meet. However, coaches must submit the weight divisions for all athletes along with their entries, two days prior to the NOSSA meet. They will only have one opportunity to weigh-in. Wrestlers who do not make weight on the morning of the meet will be disqualified from competition. Weigh-in times will be determined by the NOSSA Convener.

The combined Senior "AA"/"AAA" NOSSA Volleyball Championship shall be 6 teams (2- NDA, 2 - Sudbury, 2- Sault).

Tournament Format - Round Robin (2 pools of 3 teams). After round robin pool play, the top team in each pool will get a bye to the semi-final game. Cross pool quarter-final games will be played between the 2nd and 3rd place teams in each pool.

North Shore retains the right to (1) one entry. Should North Shore wish to enter a team, the Sault district will only advance (1) entry from their district. When there is a 3rd entry to an OFSAA, a Bronze medal game will be played.

Secondly, we would like to congratulate all the athletes, teams and coaches that represented our association at the various championships. It's nice to go to the meetings and know that not only do our teams perform well; they are also very well behaved, which is a true testament to the quality and leadership of our teacher/coaches.

NOSSA was the proud host of a great number of OFSAA championships this school year. A big thank you to Sam Levac and his outstanding Committee at West Ferris for hosting Boys and Girls AA Basketball (Fall and Winter). Sara Pickles and her crew at Chippewa hosted the Girls AA Volleyball. All three of these OFSAA's were held in North Bay (NDA). In Sudbury, Kerry Abols from Lockerby Composite and his committee picked up OFSAA Nordic Skiing and did a fantastic job hosting it at Kivi Park. Darren Michelutti and Kristi Hebert hosted a combined Hockey Championship – hosting both A-AA Girls and Boys OFSAA Hockey. By all accounts, they were extremely successful in running both these Events. On behalf of OFSAA, we thank all of these OFSAA Championship Convenors for showing the rest of the province what Great Northern Hospitality is all about.

The OFSAA Student Forums have been a big success! This year there were 3 days for students and teachers to sign up for these very informative and engaging sessions.

There were a few changes to OFSAA By-laws and also to various playing regulations at our recent AGM and we've highlighted them below. As well, the full Order Paper, with the outcome of the motions, can be viewed on the NOSSA Website. Regarding this, both Kim and I cannot emphasize this enough that it is imperative that Program Leaders, athletic heads of departments and other teacher/coaches read and review the OFSAA Order Paper and provide us with feedback to assist us in voting.

OFSAA AGM highlights:

Shamus Bourdon (Executive Director) and his staff have been leading the way to a very big announcement that will potentially change the high school sporting landscape. OFSAA has entered into a 10 year agreement with a company called Playfly Sports. This company will be partnering with OFSAA to assist with Sponsorship and Promotion of the OFSAA Brand. In essence, they will be increasing the awareness of our Brand, which will bring in \$250 000.00 this year alone. Their modest projections are to make at least that for OFSAA every year. They're initial projections are actually in the \$1 million dollar/year range (with OFSAA garnering a major share of that amount).

As well, there were roughly 45 motions at our recent AGM. Kim and I will post a result of all the new Playing Regulations. Here are a few highlights:

- New requirements for helmets for Alpine Skiing participants
- New structure for Cross-Country in the Para Division
- The use of the Traditional Pairing for the OFSAA Football Bowls every 3 years
- Upgrade in how OFSAA Classifies Open Golfers for in Girls and Boys OFSAA Golf
- Day one of Girls Golf will play as one division and on Day two, they will be split into Open and high school...Both days are Shot-gun starts.
- A small change in Nordic Skiing in Awards as well as Uniforms and Equipment (No headphones during competition)
- OFSAA Swimming saw some big changes with regards to seeding and qualifying times as well as a change to the meet schedule to accommodate for some changes to events.
- OFSAA Track and Field also made some changes to their schedule, mostly to adjust to Para events as well as the addition of the Mixed 4X400m Relay.
