3. Problems encountered:

- extremely late withdrawal of Senior Team, and only an email, no phone call
- lack of a local second entry in both the senior and junior divisions
- (why? conflict between NOSSA intent to participate deadline and nda deadline ...)
- scheduling changes week of event occurred 3X...due to uncertainty of number of entries that committed to compete.
- uncertain if local teams who had not challenged up from A to AA, could be invited last minute to replace the 2nd entry...
- also caused stress on referees assignments and travelling teams when having to change times and divisions 3X in 72 hours...
- entry fees were adjusted since less games, but still same costs for 60 medals and two banners..
- (however, received cheque to cover St. Mary Senior withdrawal)
- AA tournament hosted on date indicated on NOSSA site, AAA a day earlier, caused Korah seniors to travel separate from korah junior team -coaches and their board had implications concerning additional costs for travelling and hotels, also two school days away, plus 3 for ofsa next week.

4. Possible Recommendations:

- All districts are struggling to communicate their intentions to participate for a variety of reasons(see who wins championship in one district, do what is best for team, cost to travel,.....)
- **could we discuss making the Intent to Participate district date the same as the NOSSA Intent to Participate Deadline? (each district has a different date or process and this has caused issues in other NOSSA tournaments..)**
- it is too easy to just email a convenor and withdraw from competition....there needs to also be a conversation explaining in more detail **WHY** a team is failing to fulfill its earlier intentions....
- (why: other district coaches added more pertinent information on the weekend of the NOSSA)

3. PROBLEMS:

A) One issue was the need for several substitute host curlers. I assume it was a unique situation this year but there were several injuries/illnesses and we required 3 substitute host curlers from our pool. Although our pool was limited, we did manage to provide host curlers in order to replace the participants. We stress the importance of having a list of host players.

B) Typos were recognized in the NOSSA Constitution with respect to the format of the CONSOLATION DRAW. I sent an email to Dave Makela on Thursday, February 26 with the corrections. David responded and downloaded the corrections immediately.

C) The championship girls' team was unable to field a team and represent NOSSA at OFSAA. As a result, with this type of tournament, it was extremely difficult to figure out which team is considered the third place team. A great deal of consultation occurred and it was only resolved because one of the teams that was considered a potential "third place" contender (Korah) could also not field a team and this allowed the Lockerby team to represent NOSSA. However, it must be noted that we did not have a concrete/formal process of establishing the third place winner in this type of format. Although this was a very extremely unique situation it created a major issue.

4. RECOMMENDATIONS:

A) We used a "verification" system whereby the vices from both teams must report to the convener's table immediately after each game and confirm their score by initialing the "scorecard". This worked out very well and we would suggest using a similar type of system.

B) A process should be in place in how to determine a third place finisher in this type of "Double Elimination Tournament".

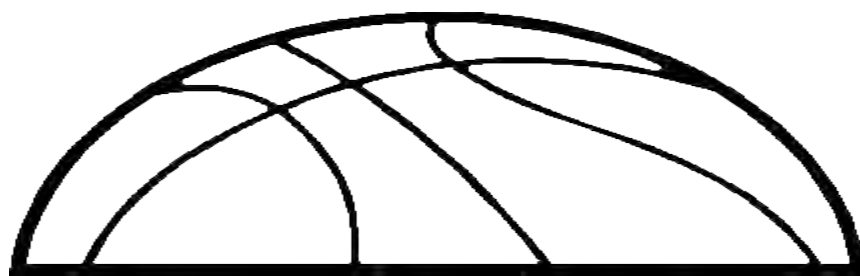

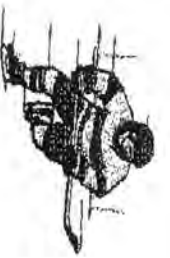

Comments, Concerns & Suggestions

Congratulations to both the Ecole Secondaire Catholique Algonquin Barons, and the College Notre Dame Allouettes for qualifying for the OFSAA 'A-AA' and 'AAA' championships respectively.

All tournament games were very competitive with the experience and talent of girls hockey throughout the NOSSA area shining throughout the entire tournament.

The tournament this year was a great format with two teams from the Sudbury area and two teams from the North Bay area competing in a round-robin style event for each of the respective classifications (8 teams total). The top two teams from the round robin then faced off again in the championship games to determine the NOSSA champions.

There ended up being an issue with determining the team that would represent the NOSSA region at the OFSAA 'A/AA' event in Kenora. Our champion, Algonquin indicated that they would not be able to make the trip, and then we continued to offer the spot to the next teams in their final placement order. In the end, no team was able to commit to the tournament despite NOSSA declaring that there would be a team going.

In the future, we would suggest that teams participating in the NOSSA championships also commit to going to OFSAA prior to the NOSSA competition if they are the successful champions at NOSSA. This will ensure that the region is represented, and that there are no sanctions to our zone, and schools within our zone.
