Lo-Ellen was seeded third at OFSAA, but lost in overtime in the quarter final game. Elliot Lake was offered entry into OFSAA when a team dropped out. COMMENTS

Congratulations to all teams. The event ran well and I have no recommendations for next year. I have no notices of change for the playing regulations. There was however one minor issue that should be noted.

The Sunday prior to the competition I received an email from White Pines coach Shauna Gravelle letting me know that they had a player on their team who attended Notre Dame. A local rule in Sault Ste. Marie allowed the athlete to play in the our league because they didn't have enough to field a team of their own. White Pines only had 7 players, including her. White Pines had decided they were going to bring her and play her at NOSSA but wanted to check the game forfeiture was the only penalty. I consulted Dave Makela about this situation and forwarded his response to Shauna. It read "the player in question is ineligible for NOSSA Competition, based on the information provided and SHOULD NOT be allowed to play at NOSSA. As the ineligibility is a known factor, the player should not be allowed on the court. It is not a matter of defaulting the game after the fact. White Pines respected the decision and did not play the athlete.

OFSAA

Concerns :

1. The AELS sheet for St-Mary's senior girls was missing four players who participated in the NOSSA championship. The players were added manually afterwards. The amalgamation of St-Basil's and St-Mary's seems to have caused some issues in this regard, however OFSAA should have been notified of this earlier in the season.
2. The North Bay junior and senior representative (Widdifield) did not participate at the AAA girls basketball championship however they did confirm their intent to participate. This was very disconcerting

given that the convener only found out at 12 :00 noon on the Friday of the competition. We were not able to find a replacement. Therefore the NOSSA constitution stipulates that :

ARTICLE XIV: SANCTIONS

SECTION 2

(a) ii. If a District is unable to honour its confirmation of intent to participate in any championship, and the convener is unable to find a replacement, the District shall be charged the entry fee for that championship, plus a \$100.00 fine. Payment will be due to the convener on the date of the championship. Failure to comply will result in a 10% late payment penalty (effective September 2002).

(b) Schools found to be in default of championship entry fees will not be permitted into any subsequent NOSSA event until such time as they convener of said championship confirms payment

3. As a convener , I found it extremely difficult to create a schedule that was fair and just with only 3 teams. As the host school, I attempted to create a schedule that did not provide any type of advantage for any school that was participating however we (Macdonald-Cartier) did find ourselves at a significant disadvantage because we had to play 3 games on the Saturday (our 3rd being the championship game against a team we had already beaten). What I recommend is that we study a format that could be used in emergency situations when a NOSSA championship only has 3 participants. This would take away the guess work from the convener.
4. I believe it is time that we (NOSSA) have a serious discussion in regards to the number of entries we are allowed for our « A » schools at OFSAA championships. We are in the process of no longer having any « AAA » schools in our region and our demographics show that this trend will probably stay. Which means that we will continue to have an abundance of « A » schools. Other regions such as EOSSA are allowed 2 entries into « A » OFSAA championships because of the number of « A » schools in that region (over 40). Our region has over 30 « A » schools . The question that we have to ask is « what is the cut off for the number of OFSAA entries per region with an

abundance of « A » schools. I understand that OFSAA has a moratorium in regards to classification standards that are being used but I believe this issue must be brought to the table.

I understand that there is a resolution at NOSSA to use a draw to the button to determine last rock, similar to the Curling Canada competition guidelines. As much as I support this in theory, there are many considerations. It does take time, a measuring device, a trained official and at least one other person to do this efficiently. In my experience, not all NOSSA curling competitions have these things in place. Secondly, if the change is not also made at OFSAA, it will be confusing to teams.

Finally, it is my recommendation that associations register for the NOSSA event on time. Teams were not confirmed until the very last minute, and it is a hardship for the host.
