Successes and Area's for Improvement:

- 1) The issue of a date change to the NOSSA championship posed some problems for the travelling team.

Suggestion: Since 90 % plus of basketball tournaments are held on weekends, I would suggest that NOSSA always be played Friday and Saturday, with 1 game on the first night (due to travel), and 2 games on the Saturday; a morning semi final and late day/evening for the championship.

- 2) 2 team NOSSA championship. With declining enrollment combined with schools amalgamating, it may be beneficial to look at an alternative format for the NOSSA championship. I would suggest looking at the motion brought forward by Denis Gauthier (Lasalle) – Megan Chute (Lasalle). With only 2 recognized teams that are required to compete at AAA', it would be fair and equitable if teams from all regions at the AA and AAA level competed for the two spots in a NOSSA showdown, therefore providing the best two teams to prolong their season and BEST represent the North.

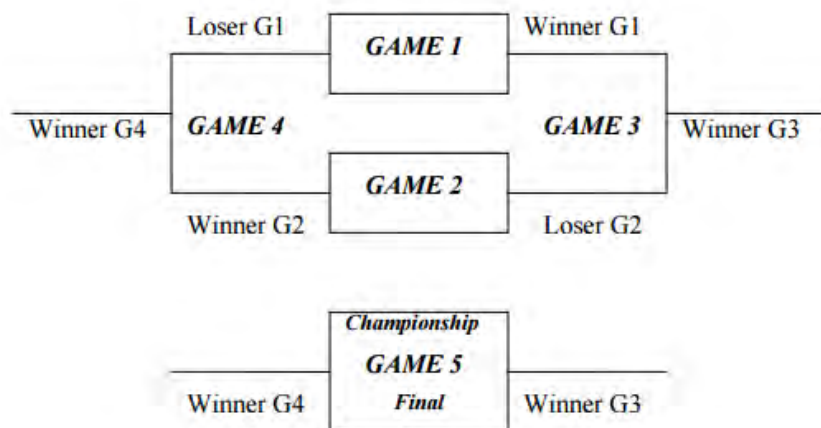

And whereas; the current format can be confusing to most.

- Due to above normal precipitation weeks prior to the NOSSA Championship, the City of Sault Ste. Marie cancelled permits for 2 of 4 soccer fields just 4 days prior to the start of NOSSA. These cancellations forced the convenor to re-schedule games using 3 fields instead of 5.
- According to the NOSSA constitution, start times and the minimum number of hours between games was an issue.
- The re-scheduling of the games with limited field access lengthened the NOSSA tournament and Championship start times. This in turn forces teams to be cognizant of "travel hours" for bus drivers.
- One of the natural grass fields was not cut prior to the NOSSA games and teams were delayed.

RECOMMENDATIONS/CONCERNS

1. The weather on day two was wet and cold but the event ran smoothly and mostly ahead of schedule.
2. Two protests were heard during the two-day competition. One involved using the wrong implement weight at midget boys shot put and the other referenced a starter's no false start call after a 200m runner stumbled out of the blocks.
3. There were some concerns received with respect to athletes scratching and then competing in subsequent events, but a follow up yielded no confirmation.
4. At least two athletes missed their first event on Wednesday not realizing the schedule started one hour earlier when NOSSSA is hosted in Sudbury. A motion will be forwarded to standardize start times regardless of site to prevent this from recurring.

NOSSA cross-country ran smoothly. We stay on schedule and there were no problems with results or with athletes running off course.

A few points of consideration:

- 🍏 The scheduled used for 2017 was modified from the playing regulations so that the para race ran first followed by Midget girls, Midget Boys, Junior Girls, Junior Boys, Senior Girls then Senior Boys. With the change to the distances this year (Midget 4km, Junior 5km and Senior 6km) this made sense to have the para race (3km) before the others and avoid having to set up a new course 3 times instead of 1.
- 🍏 The only para runner chose to run with the midget boys. No changes were made to the established schedule because of this.
- 🍏 The start and finish line where at two different locations which enable us to start on time even with the changes to course distances and time of the events. (girls run longer, boys run shorter than previous years however the same time between races is allocated in the playing regulation)
- 🍏 The card system was used for team points as a backup but was not needed as the Timing system (CHIP TIME RESULTS) has a redundant back-up system of their own.
- 🍏 All races consisted of two identical loops making up the required total distance. We received much positive feedback for the course layout. Although very muddy, it was spectator friendly. Many coaches commented that they liked the trails used and the course lay-out.
