The regulations pertaining to NOSSA and OFSSA Golf are still being questioned by coaches due to lack of clarity in literature. Especially when pertaining to carded or open players and high school players. The feed back from the kids is that they think its not fair for a kid (that is carded) who shot 75 not to attend OFSSA while another who shot 79 (not carded) does.

I personally think that Emmett Taillefer, a carded player who shot 75 should be able to attend the OFSSA championship. First of all, one of his school mates, Tristan Renaud, qualified. Therefore, the costs incurred for lodging and traveling from Sudbury could be split by the two boys. Also, being a grade 12 student, this is the last opportunity for this great golfer to participate, and also add talent to the field at the championship. Emmett approached me in a very polite manner and demonstrated excellent sportsmanship when talking about qualifying. As an organiser that didn't know Emmett before yesterday, I was impressed by his demeanor and maturity. These two qualities make it as such as an invitation would be in line with how golfers behave and interact with peers and teachers. I hope you can accommodate this young lad.

Convenor Comments:

- Feb. 20th was the third attempt at running this event due to snow days on Feb. 12 in North Bay and Feb. 13th in North Bay and Sudbury. The North Bay Nordic Ski Club was very accommodating to our request to reschedule.
- Ninety-two (92) athletes participated in NOSSA Nordic this year, including two para nordic (standing) athletes. Last NOSSA hosted by NDA in 2016 also had 92 athletes.
- No athletes participated from North Shore schools this year.
- Thank you to the other NDA coaches for your assistance in running this event.

Convenor Recommendations:

- Changes to NOSSA Playing Regulations needed. See below. What is the process to get these changes addressed?
- Future convenors should contact coaches of para nordic athletes to ensure a race course that suits the abilities of the para nordic athletes. A relatively easy course of 3km was recommended by coaches this year. The 3km Purple trail at the North Bay Nordic Club was used for the para Nordic skiers.

Changes to NOSSA Nordic Playing Regulations

- References to trophies? To my knowledge, these have not been awarded in the past few years. Are they still to be awarded and if so, where are they?
- There is no language in the NOSSA playing regulations regarding paranordic categories. This will need to be added in the future. In the most recent OFSAA Nordic playing regulations, paranordic and special needs categories are listed as a demonstration event. Do we consider awarding NOSSA medals to para Nordic skiers, or do we refer to it as a demonstration event?
- Language needs to be improved regarding what constitutes a qualifying team. After discussion with some coaches, the following was agreed upon for this event. This wording should be revisited.

Team Qualification: For teams with more than five skiers in a category (i.e. junior boys), the top 5 skiers from the NOSSA results for that school will automatically be designated as Team A, unless a coach/school declares their A and B athletes prior to NOSSA by contacting the convenor prior to the registration deadline. If a school has enough skiers to field a full Team B, that Team B will be eligible to qualify for OFSSA if they are the second place team based on NOSSA results.
