



\*\* There were no trophies handed out. Medals were awarded to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place finishers and ribbons were distributed to 3<sup>rd</sup> place finishers. There were fun prizes awarded for the winners of the relays as well. Aggregate banners were also handed out to deserving teams.

#### 2. Problems encountered:

- 1) 6 first place medals were missing from the lot of medals. However, they were delivered at the OFSAA race and distributed to deserving athletes at that time.
- 2) Similarly for the NDA race, organization with the North Bay Nordic Ski Club became difficult when trying to set-up race layout in the trails (specifically the backwards brown), equipment, facility and bib use as well as fees. In the future, when dealing with the North Bay Nordic Ski Club, I strongly suggest a contract be written and signed by both parties at the time of reservation to ensure all the details are well established and agreed upon at the beginning of the planning process.

#### 3. Recommendations for next year:

- 1) At the request of athletes and coaches banners should be distributed to winning teams. The athletes anticipate banners to be awarded to the championship team as in other NOSSA event such as Cross Country, and Track and Field.
- 2) In concordance with OFSAA categorise and prizes (and eligibility qualifications for OFSAA) the aggregate banners should be replaced with Junior Combined and Senior Combined banners thus awarding importance to the same group of athletes as OFSAA does. The aggregate banners at NOSSA seem not to have a place or importance in Nordic skiing.
- 2) The relays races (fun or competitive, standard or sprint) should continue to be part of the day's events. Informal relays are relatively easy to organise and add a new element of competition to a NOSSA event. It may also be the only opportunity, prior to the OFSAA championship, for athletes to compete and practice in the event.

### Section #3: Problems Encountered:

This championship was virtually flawless until the final senior 'AA' championship game.

During this game, there were many comments made about the officiating by the St. Mary's coaching staff and players, resulting in two members of the coaching staff being ejected from the game. In addition, there were a few yellow and red cards issued to players of both teams during the course of the match.

While these are not acceptable behaviours, the officiating staff handled it professionally, and their reports were filed and noted. Were the problem came was dealing with how the suspensions affected the St. Mary's team and their progression to the OFSAA championships the following week. After consulting with many regional NOSSA executives and OFSAA personnel, it was concluded that there was insufficient wording in the NOSSA constitution to explicitly and effectively apply the correct suspensions for any/all further OFSAA competition games.

Finally, the local soccer league from which St. Mary's qualified from, handled the suspension of the student and coaches involved.

As a convenor, I feel that it should be the job of the NOSSA sport committee to look to the playing regulations and immediately hand out further suspensions carrying forward to OFSAA. This would be clear at the conclusion of the NOSSA championship rather than running into time constraints and availability of other people from their home leagues, given the tight timelines between the NOSSA and OFSAA soccer championships. These instructions are not outlined in our current NOSSA playing regulations.

#### Section #4: Recommendations For Next Year:

With respect to recommendations for next year, I strongly encourage the next convenor(s) to implement the following:

- Two playing sites
- Site Convenor for each site
- Order four or more (two for each site) OFSAA soccer balls to be used during

the competition

Lots of water available at each site

In addition, I believe that the NOSSA soccer playing regulations must be looked at to include wording about how to deal with players and coaches receiving yellow/red cards and ejections in all games. The wording must include all possible suspensions that would carry forward to the next NOSSA game (where applicable) and certainly to the OFSAA competition that the winning team would participate in the following week.

Held in Sudbury at MacDonald Cartier, Feb 18, 2011

For the most part, this year's NOSSA went very well.

126 wrestlers participated, with 62 coming from Sudbury area high schools.

The officials and the Pairey Master were very well managed and did a great job as usual.

#### Some recommendations for the future.

- 1. There was a bit of confusion with a few coaches as to who was hosting NOSSA Wrestling this year. Last year Sturgeon Falls was the host, this year it was Sudbury's turn and next year Sault Ste Marie. (Each area is on a 3-year rotation) For the last two year's, the NOSSA website has the wrong host area listed.
- 2. In the future either we shouldn't have a charge back for local schools, and /or, out of town schools should be required to pay their entry fee **before competition** begins. This will result in the organizers not having to loan money to the event in order to ensure officials and their expenses are covered. Incidentally, NOSSA is still waiting for the cheque from CASS covering entry fees for this year's NOSSA Wrestling.

The money owing to OFSAA Wrestling 2011 was to cover an immediate shortfall at the event. With having \$1240.00 worth of entry fees to the Sudbury Schools charged back, as well as having to give the schools from Central Algoma a bill (so that they could have a cheque written from their Board), made it difficult to run the event. Money has to be available for the Officials, Lodging and other tournament related expenses, on the day of the tournament.

Nossa cross country running 2010-11 convener's report

2. Winning coaches: Boys banner – Kerry Abols and Laura Stanyon, Lockerby Composite School.

Girls banner – Collin Ward and Destiny Gratton, Loellen Park Secondary School.

- 3. Problems encountered this year:
  - Tight turnaround time for Ofsaa entries.
  - Tight timeline for protest resolution.
  - Question and concern over the competitor uniform rule.
  - Some teams did not properly register prior to the entry deadline.
- 4. Reccomendations for next year:
  - Change the uniform rule so that it can be enforced more justly. The rule currently states that all runners on a team must compete in identical school running tops. Although not in the playing regulations it is normally indicated in the nossa cc meet package that runners not adhering to the uniform rule will be disqualified. In most other sports athletes are not allowed to compete or start if they are not wearing the proper uniform, an official alerts them to change into the proper uniform prior to the start of the competition. At ofsaa cross country there are several officials at the start ensuring that athletes are wearing the proper uniform before the start. It is not feasible at nossa for the starter to inspect the uniform of all runners before each race. Disqualifying an athlete after the completion of the race for a uniform violation is a very harsh penalty, considering the starter/official at nossa can not properly inspect all competitors. The onus should still be on the athlete and team to follow the rules, but the penalty should not be so harsh. Perhaps there should be a fine levied against a school team for violating the uniform rule.
