Luckily the double elimination format helped to decrease the magnitude of this scheduling error. There is a motion to NOSSA this year to clarify this seeding format in the constitution.

Recommendations for next year are presented in the four motions to NOSSA for 2008 from our Badminton coaches meeting. They are to: increase fee's to \$ 10 per athlete, add "for each event" to the seeding format, add a Chief Referee to NOSSA Badminton, and to ensure that doubles and mixed players from the same team must wear matching, solid coloured shorts.





A number of problems have come to my attention with regard to how certain processes are handled at NOSSA. These problems stem from the lack of detail and order in the NOSSA COED Curling Playing Regulations. Rules for Substitution must be amended to mirror those of OFSAA, not only so there is a clear ruling on what should be done, but also so there is no confusion about the rule for the teams who qualify for OFSAA. The issue mainly encountered at this years championship was that teams refused to chose a substitute player from the available pool, and made the decision to play with only three players. The issue of and appeal process must be dealt with. In OFSAA regulations there is a process that must be followed when a coach has a problem with a rule etc. Also eligibility forms should be sent to the convenor prior to the Championship's start date.

For future events, a more inclusive draw should be made to make better use of all available ice surfaces. Furthermore, sufficient time between the start and end of draws should be allotted for the preparation of the ice surface i.e. no back-to-back draws. If time dose allow, a practice before each game should be scheduled to allow teams to warm up.

NOSSA CURLING PLAYING REGULATIONS MOTIONS

Motion to NOSSA to add the following to the Curling COED Playing regulations;

Age and eligibility: see NOSSA constitution, Article VII

Remove current sections on ages and eligibility in the NOSSA Curling COED playing regulations.

Rational: current regulations in conflict with constitution and does not include all information.

Mover: Gilbert Briscoe Seconder: Laura Aubertin

Motion to NOSSA to add the following to the NOSSA Curling COED playing regulations;

Rules and Officials: The rules governing the play shall be that of the Canadian Curling Association. Any exceptions to be specified in the NOSSA COED Curling Playing regulations.

Rational: Current playing regulations do not stipulate what rules are to be used however OFSAA does. OFSAA rules of play are the CCA rules.

Mover: Gilbert Briscoe Seconder: Laura Aubertin

Motion to NOSSA to add the following to the NOSSA Curling COED playing regulations;

Substitution: Where possible, the host Association shall be responsible for providing a pool of curlers available for substitution.

- (i) During the competition if a team has only four (4) players and one player is unable to continue play because of illness or injury, they must select randomly from the host pool of curlers and that player shall be lead; if the original player is able to play again he/she may re-enter the competition at the beginning of a game.
- (ii) Once a player is selected from the host pool, he/she must remain that team's substitute until such time as the original player (or alternate) can return.

Remove current sections on substitution in the NOSSA Curling COED playing regulations.

Rational: Current rule is not in keeping with the CCA rule. The new procedure mirrors OFSAA. Teams are abusing the current substitution rule.

Mover: Gilbert Briscoe Seconder: Laura Aubertin

Motion to NOSSA to add the following to the NOSSA Curling COED playing regulations;

Timeouts: A maximum of three (3) minutes consultation between the coach and curlers shall be allowed on the ice only, at the completion of the fourth end. In addition, two (2) one minute time outs (i.e. one time out of one minute) may be called at any time while your team is in control of the house. The team that called the time out may access the playing surface. Coaches must wear appropriate footwear to access the ice surface. The team that did not call the time out may confer with the coach, but may not access the playing surface. The Fair Play timeout rule shall be in effect.

- (i) Practice time, to a maximum of seven (7) minutes per team, shall be made available before each game if time permits. The team with the hammer in the first end shall practise first.
- (ii) A minimum of 20 minutes prior to game time, the opposing vices will meet behind the glass of their designated sheets to toss for choice of last rock or rock colour. The team with last rock will have first practice.
- (i) No high school students shall be used as on-ice officials. (Except timeouts, NOSSA convener may appoint student volunteers.)
- (ii) Permanent hog-line judges shall not be introduced part way through a competition.

Remove current sections on timeouts in the NOSSA Curling COED playing regulations.

Rational: Selections on practice time and timeouts shall be added to better mirror OFSAA. Current rules do not include selections on practice time.

Mover: Gilbert Briscoe Seconder: Laura Aubertin

Motion to NOSSA to add the following to the NOSSA Curling COED playing regulations;

Jury of Appeal: The Jury of Appeal shall consist of three (3) individuals: NOSSA Convenor, a tournament committee member and one (1) other member appointed by the NOSSA Convenor who is neutral to the dispute (cannot be a student). The Jury of Appeal shall handle disputes which fall within the realm of:

- (a) Tournament Structure and Procedure;
- (b) Rules and Officials;
- (c) Equipment;
- (d) Scoring.

Tournament structure and procedure concerns shall be addressed no later than the end of the coaches' meeting.

A dispute must be submitted in writing to the Convenor or Designate together with a \$50.00 fee (refundable if dispute is upheld) within thirty (30) minutes, except as provided within specific

sport governing regulations, of the conclusion of the game in which the incident under dispute occurred. Decisions of the Jury of Appeal shall be final.

Remove current sections on officials in the NOSSA Curling COED playing regulations.

Rational: Current rules do not include procedures on appealing or implications of decisions.

Motion to NOSSA to omit the following from the NOSSA Curling COED playing regulations;

General 3. Artificial ice and matched rocks must be available at the site recommended for the Championship.

Rational: The rule is obsolete. Every Curling Club in the Association's district has artificial ice and matched rocks.

Mover: Gilbert Briscoe Seconder: Laura Aubertin

Motion to NOSSA to omit the following from the NOSSA Curling COED playing regulations;

Third place ribbons shall no longer be awarded.

Rational: No other team sports are awarded third place at NOSSA. The current draw does not allow for a third place winner to be declared.



Problems/Recommendations for Next Year:

From comments I received, it is my understanding that the meet was judged a success, however there were some issues that need to be discussed:

- 1. There was confusion on my part, yet all coaches were in agreement at the coaches meeting, about the scratch rule. In two separate places in the NOSSA playing regulations there is information about scratching. Unfortunately I only drew my attention to the scratching 30 minutes before the start of the days events part and we all went with that rule. It clearly states 5 pages later that anyone who scratches will be ineligible to compete in any of their subsequent events. I know that it is my responsibility to know the rules, so I take full responsibility for this error, however, my recommendation is that the rules on scratches be placed **together** in the playing regulations so that this error can be avoided in the future. My apologies for the error, but as we all agreed at the coaches meeting, everyone had the same advantage this year.
- 2. There were issues with coaching in the field events during competition. My officials have always been given strict instruction not to allow any coaching as it is in our constitution. There were complaints about this from coaches that the officials were putting a stop to coaching and warning of possible disqualification. Upon checking the IAAF rules, it was determined that communication outside the competition area, provided it was not disruptive to other competitors, was allowed. I put a note in the officials package for them to designate and area were athletes can converse with their coaches. I discussed the matter with Dave Makela and we could not draw a clear line as to what was coaching and what was simply communicating and I think this issue is a little fuzzy. I recommend making this more clear in the NOSSA playing regulations so that we are all aware of what were are allowed to do for our athletes.
- 3. Computer Entries: Many birth dates were not submitted in the Hy-Tek program. Although not a huge issue, I did spend an hour or two entering birth dates. This was time consuming at a point when I did not have a lot of time to spare. Please ensure your district entries have all birth dates entered before sending them to the NOSSA convener. You do not even want to know what my recommendations are for people who do not include birth dates are:)
- 4. Weather: It was cold and rainy on the second day. I recommend that Mother Nature be more co-operative in the future.

I think that is everything. I hope everyone enjoyed the meet despite the weather. I am not sure what is happening next year as I am not sure if Sudbury's track will be ready in time, but I have spoken to our Community Services Department, and she has asked that we not host NOSSA again next year as it interferes with the elementary school meets and ties up many of her staff. Two years in a row is too much...not that I wouldn't enjoy hosting it again.

The date for NOSSA A Girls Volleyball was declared a Snow Day in Sudbury. The school buses were cancelled, however schools remained open. The NOSSA Constitution does not indicate any procedures for such an event. As some teams from outside the host district were already in Sudbury, I decided to proceed with the tournament. Unfortunately, Franco-Cite from Sturgeon Falls (who had both a junior and a senior team in the tournament) were unable to make the trip to Sudbury for the competition as their buses were also unavailable. Should NOSSA look at a standard policy for such situations?

Recommendations:

Since we used two sites for the tournament (which is becoming normal practice), a schedule this type of tournament setup should be included in the playing regulations. Flexibility for scheduling should remain, dependent upon the location of the host site.

Contact numbers should be forwarded to the convener of the tournament, especially when a team is traveling into a district. As well, the tournament convener should supply complete contact information to the coaches. This information would facilitate communication amongst the participants.

OFSAA's AELs system for providing eligibility lists should be made mandatory for all sports at the NOSSA level.
