**4) Recommendations :**

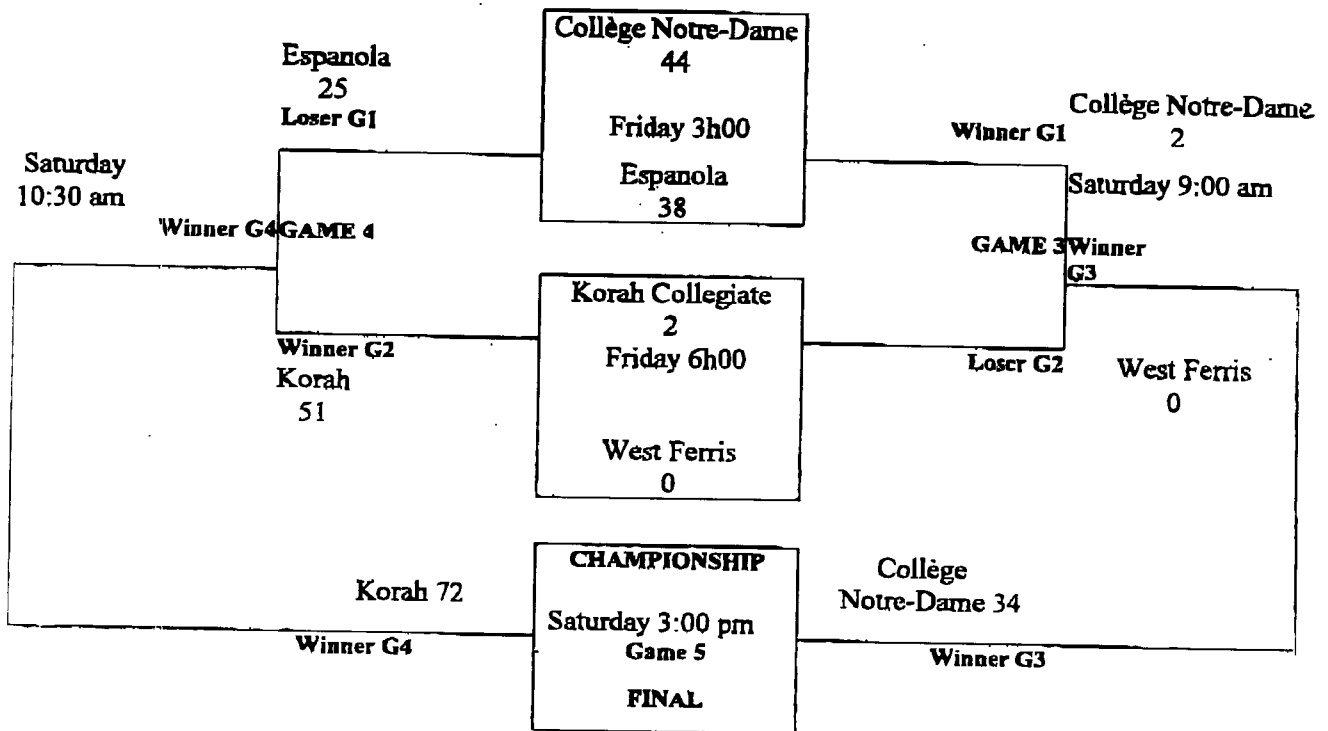

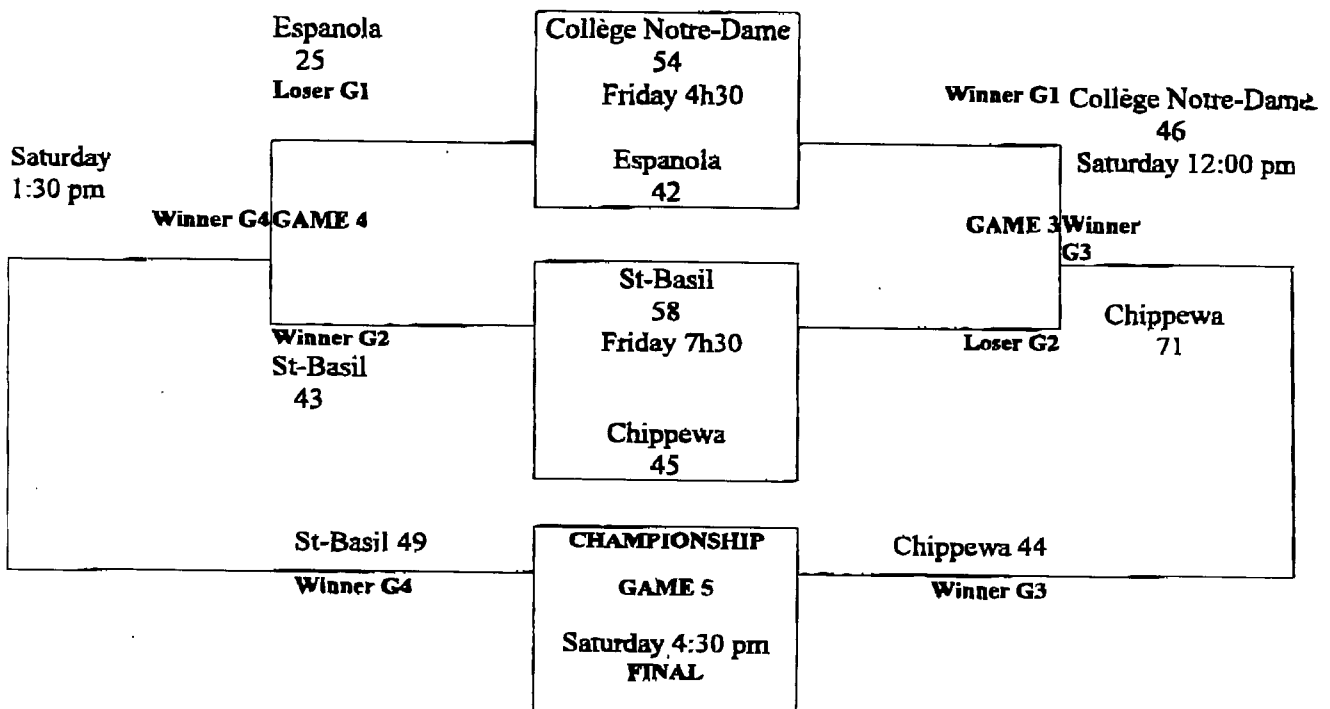

### **Recommendations/Comments**

- 1) With the H1N1 illness that has taken place (note the participation at NOSSA C-C running was at 65% of those that had registered) and the postponement of other high school games/tournaments, the question must be asked: “Is there a back up date or plan for NOSSA cross-country running if circumstances dictate that it cannot be run on the scheduled date?”.
- 2) We had one protest this year due to the fact that a coach after noticing that the first five, six or seven runners in the midget girls’ race took the wrong turn decided that he would direct all runners to take that wrong turn. This, in his mind, was to ensure that NOSSA’s best runners would qualify to go to OFSAA. But it took away the opportunity for runners to make their own decisions (“runners must know their course”) and for runner who knew the course to make their move (as this wrong turn shorten the race by close to one kilometer) during the last stages of the race.

Do we have a ‘consequence’ for a coach who **knowingly** makes runners take the wrong course? If not, should we and what should those consequences be?

- 3) A second banner for girls’ aggregate must be made and passed on to Sir James Dunn or Korah (whichever school did not get the original).
