Hosting NOSSA in a small community like Thessalon created some minor problems. The local hotel could only house one out of town team so rooms needed to be secured in nearby communities (10 - 15 minutes away). More money had to be spent on travel for officials (coming from the Sault). Limited choices of restaurants might have been a problem although no teams made formal complaints.

On the positive side, an event like NOSSA hockey was a positive for the town of Thessalon. 
