

#### 2022 NOSSA Cross Country Convener's Report

Date: October 26

Location: North Bay Ontario – Pinewood Park Golf Course

Entries: 417 total entries. Due to scratches there were fewer finishers as evidenced by the results.

#### Issues encountered this year:

Overall the day ran smoothly thanks to having Chip Time results doing the timing. There were a few things that came up:

- 1. Two schools, one fairly large team, did not meet the registration deadline and did not have any entries for NOSSA the day of the race when they showed up. Thankfully Chip Time results were able to accommodate but only because there were scratches from other teams. If athletes had not scratched, Chip Time, despite having brought 20 extra timing chips/bibs would not have had enough extras to accommodate all of the late entries.
- 2. During one race (junior Girls) the lead biker did the order of the loops incorrectly. The race package indicated that athletes were to complete the 2k loop then the 3 k loop. Our biker misunderstood and did the 3 k loop first. The Marshall at this corner caught it right away and all athletes followed the biker so there were no issues. All athletes in this race completed the 5 K distance in the same order as the others. A couple of athletes who had pre-run the course did run about 20 meters on the original correct loop but the marshal was able to get them to make the adjustment right away (he called to them right away but they ended up a few meters down trail). No coaches reported that it had impacted the results in any way.
- 3. The last issue was more administrative. The constitution calls for first place teams to get medals and 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place teams to get ribbons. In the box of awards delivered there were no second place ribbons for teams so we handed out medals to the team members instead as we felt that students needed to be awarded something for their achievement. NOSSA XC reimbursed NOSSA for the cost of the medals.

#### **Recommendations**

One recommendation that I have is to make sure that all teams have their entries in by the deadline. I also recommend that next year's convener ask the timing company, whoever it is, to bring more than a few extra chips/bibs in case we have another situation like this year. In the end it was resolved and all athletes got to run which was the main thing.

A couple of schools paid for fees with cash, small schools with small numbers of athletes. We had no change for these coaches as we do not have cash at our school for any reason. They said it was alright and they understood but we had no way to reimburse them. This is why the total amount collected is a little higher than what the actual amount was. (\$5421.00 vs. \$5449.00).

#### New This year:

This year we tried live-streaming the event so that parents/grandparents etc... could watch the races. This was met with a great deal of positive comments. We even had someone interviewing the individual race winners and commenting throughout the race. If schools have this ability, it is a great addition. We were lucky that we had a connection with our local community college and one of our staff who were able to make it work.

#### **Budget notes**

It is difficult to set a per/athlete fee without knowing the actual number of athletes in advance. Based on the last few years it ranged anywhere from high 300's to mid-400. We worked with a number around 400. Since team sizes vary from year to year this was the most challenging piece. In the end we erred a little on the safe side and this resulted with us having a small surplus at the end of the day (\$188.52). Based on estimated costs we charged \$13 per athlete. Actual cost came out to \$12.61 per.

**Facilities:** Includes venue rental plus portable toilets.

**Awards:** Includes the extra medals we used in lieu of the missing ribbons.

This was a team effort and it turned out to be a great event (It didn't hurt that it was about 20 degrees and sunny for most of the day). I also want to thank Dave Makela who was very helpful any time I had NOSSA related questions.

# **NOSSA Report - Golf**

### A. Results

#### **NOSSA Boys**

### B. Problems

For the most part, the event was completed without any major problems. The following are areas of concern:

#### 1. Payment from each region

a. Sudbury and North Bay paid for their regions with a single cheque but North Shore was not able to do that and provided individual payments for each school participating. Some schools did not bring payment at all and the convenor had to "chase" after the funds following the event. This is something that needs to be corrected for next year as payment is a big area of workload for the convenor and this would reduce that load significantly.

#### 2. Pace of play for girls' groups.

a. This was an issue raised in last year's report so my hope is that a solution can be implemented for next year. See below for a suggestion.

#### 3. Rules knowledge

a. Many players, including the top-level players were not sure of some important rules like playing a ball from "out of bounds" for example. Lack of knowledge of

these rules when competing at NOSSA is not acceptable and is a major contributor to slow play and makes it near impossible to have a fair contest. See below for a suggestion.

# **C.** Recommendations

- 1. **Payment** The following is suggested to improve fee collection.
  - a. North Shore golf coaches need to meet with their school staffs to ensure they are prepared for this method of payment next year. Coaches should reach out to the other regions already doing this in Sudbury and Nipissing to learn the process. If needed, have school staffs communicate with each other.
- 2. <u>Pace of play for girls</u> The following is suggested to improve pace of play.
  - a. During local NOSSA qualifiers, pace of play is to be monitored. Regardless of score, if a player is not able to keep a pace of 4.5 hours or less on a par 72 golf course, they will not be eligible for NOSSA
- 3. Rules Knowledge The following is suggested to improve fair play
  - a. I suggest each school be required to demonstrate that they have reviewed and that their players understand the basic rules of golf. I suggest a rules presentation be prepared (I can offer to do that for next year) for the NOSSA region and the expectation is that all coaches review and confirm knowledge of the information within.
  - b. Coaches would need to sign off that they have reviewed the rules with their players and that players understand the consequences (disqualification) for not counting scores accurately.

#### 4/ Recommendations for next year

"Be it resolved that NOSSA Alpine constitute, two slalom runs done first, and one GS run done after slalom. When time permits, two GS runs will take place".

If it is the will of the NOSSA Alpine coaches – through their athletic directors – to keep our current practice, they can vote **FOR** the motion. If they do not agree, they can vote **NO**, and we can keep our current playing regs in play, which state two GS runs must occur. The order is not clearly stated, so that could be some housekeeping.

#### **CONVENOR REPORT - NORDIC SKIING (February 16th, 2023)**

On February 16th, students from NDA, North Shore, SDSS and SSMD attended the NOSSA Championship at North Bay Nordic. It was a great success with the addition of Sault schools this year. There were approximately 145 athletes involved. This is an increase from previous years of about 100 athletes.

As the event ran smoothly, there are some recommendations that can be addressed at the AGM in April 2023. Please see these recommendations below:

- 1) The event MUST be placed early on in a week, preferably a Tuesday or Wednesday before OFSAA. With weather related issues, we need back-up plans for later in the week so that preparations can be made in a reasonable amount of time for OFSAA.
- 2) Zone4 Timing was used with this event. Although it is quite expensive, it worked very well. There are cheaper variations of the equipment, and if confident, an older system can be used effectively with the proper knowledge on spreadsheets for results.
- 3) This year, we had to make an emergency addendum to the playing regulations. We would like to formally change the playing regulation of Junior Boys/Girls at 5KM and Senior Boys/Girls at 7KM race distances as per the OFSAA regulations.
- 4) Fees were charged at \$15.00 per athlete to cover the timing and facility rental. Please be aware to prepare properly with the facility to be sure the numbers of athletes can be accommodated by working with board of directors from host facility.
- 5) Recommend and accommodation to the 4-year calendar of host district. With the Sault Schools joining Nordic, we would like to have that district host in 2024-25. Currently it shows Nipissing as the host. 2023-24 (Sudbury). 2024-25 (Sault). 2025-26 (North Bay). 2026-27 (Sudbury).
