

2. **Problems Encountered this year:**

We had a big discussion about the format. For my whole time as coach (17 yearsish) we've done an elimination tournament with semis, finals and consolation finals for 3rd and 4th).

NOSSA Playing Regs say we should be doing a Round Robin tournament:

"The NOSSA tournament shall be a four (4) team round-robin tournament with each district guaranteed one (1) entry. No playoff match will be played. If there is a tie between teams after the round-robin, the head-to-head matches between the tied teams will be the tiebreaker. If teams are still tied, the number of games will be looked at to break the tiebreaker."

The time restriction on courts and length of day is tough for any kind of round robin type of format. It's likely a judgment call every year depending on how much court time North Bay has. We have lots of court time and Sudbury likely has the least.

3. The format for the tournament is somewhat restricted by availability of courts and the number of courts on site. We finished the tournament this year early (around 2pm) because Manitoulin Secondary has 4 courts to utilize for the day. This would likely mean that a Round Robin tournament would be possible if the location has sufficient courts. We would be looking at around 20 matches to complete the round robin plus then playoffs and finals. Having access to less than 4 courts may pose time constraints on completing a Round Robin NOSSA within one day.

RECOMMENDATIONS/CONCERNS

- 1. This year's event was preceded by an on-line (zoom) coaches meeting. We were able to field a lot of questions from coaches before teams arrived which was very beneficial.
- 2. Washroom facilities at Laurentian were overwhelmed. Port-a-potties were ordered through the city but were not delivered in time.
- 3. To mid-April, organizers still did not receive an invoice from Laurentian for the provision of parking guards.
- 4. Despite the hiring of parking guards, there was a lot of confusion about parking, bus transportation and access to free parking for officials. The logistics attached to host at Laurentian made larger events challenging to organize effectively.
- 5. There was an unfortunate error made in the North Region entries' qualification process that prevented a North Bay student from advancing. This led to a series discussion about changing the entire process, but in the end it will be status quo with a few tweaks implemented to facilitate a review process before the information is posted.
