I recommend a motion to NOSSA to change the playing regulations to reflect the current practice of for NOSSA Alpine.

***“Be it resolved that NOSSA Alpine eligibility part c be changed from its current state”:***

ALPINE ELIGIBILITY C) Members of current Northern Ontario Divisional teams **are ineligible** for the NOSSA meet.

***“And it be changed to read”***

ALPINE ELIGIBILITY C) Members of current Northern Ontario Divisional teams **are eligible** for the NOSSA meet.

Provincial team members are ineligible for NOSSA Alpine. However, current practice in our Association is that members of a Northern Ontario Divisional (NOD) team are permitted to participate at NOSSA.

This housekeeping change would align current practice with the Eligibility Part C section of the Alpine playing regulations.

*3) Problems encountered this year:*

***Incident 1.***Game 4 which saw Algonquin vs White Pines. Patrent in the crowd were not conducting themselves in a way that follows the OFSA code of conduct. At half-time, both teams went to different changerooms. I took the opportunity to speak to both groups of fans and reminded them that there are expectations when it comes to behaviour, cheering, and letting the refs make the calls.

*During that time, the White Pines team was very aggressive in the changerooms, swearing, punching, and kicking walls and doors. Unfortunately, the male staff office is in the boys' change room so everything could be heard. At one point, staff thought there was a fight going on in the changeroom so they opened the office door to look into the changeroom. They were surprised to see the community coaches in the changeroom with the team and allowing that sort of behaviour.*



*The game finished a little chippy. As the players were shaking hands, I was bringing the scoresheet into my office so that I could update Dave Makela and start preparing for Saturday. A player from the White Pine's team came to my office door and in front of two other staff, asked me how much I paid the refs so they would lose.*

*Again my office is in the boys' change room, and I left my office and stood at the entrance of the changeroom to talk to that player about his comment. I was expecting the coaching staff to be in there but they were outside debriefing. The players were still dressed and just sitting there talking to each other on two benches. As I started to talk to the player who made the comment, when another player rudely told me it was the boys' change room and that I should leave. I left the changeroom right away to go find the coaches for the White Pine team. They were just outside the door entrance to the changeroom. and explained that they needed to control their players. They did their job and went to speak to them.*

*The coaches then came to my office door/ entrance to the changeroom, and we got into a heated argument over the whole situation. I explained to the coaches that their team and fan conduct was unacceptable according to the OFSAA.*

*As a convener, I was thinking about removing those two players from the tournament for conduct displayed to on-court, off-court, and towards Refs, Scorekeepers, and Convener, and disallowing fan entrance for conduct displayed to on-court officials, opponents, and scorekeepers during the last round robin game. At first, the coaches were aggressive with me but soon started to see our point of view. They didn't want their players to be ejected and didn't want their fans to be banned as they drove a long way. I asked them to give me 5 minutes to talk to the other Convener Michael McQuarrie and we would make a decision.*

*I met with their teacher rep and explained to him that we would continue the way it was but that the players were warned and the fans were warned.*

### **NOSSA Championship**

The NOSSA championship was held on Tuesday, February 11<sup>th</sup>. Kevin Magill, Greg MacLachlan, Cam Wilson, and Shane Dunne were there Monday, February 10<sup>th</sup> for the preski. There was music playing and v-boards and convenors directed athletes and coaches to ski at least one lap of the 2.5km course. The course was the same as the city meet (1 loop for exhibition and paranordic, 2 loops for junior skiers in grades 9/10, and 3 loops for senior skiers in grades 11/12) of the lighted 2km trail with the addition of what we call “Shane loops” or “Brady’s Brother’s loops.” Either terminology will suffice.

There was debate amongst coaches earlier in the year between those who preferred a more challenging course such as the Crystal 5km (very hilly terrain and challenging) and those who preferred 2 laps of the 2 km lighted trail (less challenging and flat but better for spectating and less skilled skiers) The majority of Soo and NOSSA coaches felt that the less challenging 2km trail was more beneficial for keeping kids safe and continuing to ski.

Big thanks to Cassandra Nielsen for setting up zone 4 for the event and Chris Clowater and other volunteers both from the ADSB and the Soo Finnish Nordic Club who timed the event. We had about 30 volunteers between coaches, parents, ADSB staff, and Soo Finnish members who helped the event run smoothly.

After the event, all coaches relayed to the convenors that it was an awesome event. The 2.5km course was about as challenging as the one athletes came across at Kivi park for OFSAA the next week.
