Convenor Notes:

- I would suggest a change be made to the warm-up format to a simple 5-5-5. This would follow current policy in OCCA, OUA, OVA, etc. where there is 5 minutes of general ball handling, then 5 minutes each for the two teams to take to the court and hit, pass, serve (team choice) with first 5 minutes allotted to the first service team followed by 5 minutes for the receiving team of first service.
- Currently, the schedules in the NOSSA constitution do not support the changes to match format. I suggest taking my 2 day schedule above with a slight change in moving the Senior Final to 4:00pm to reflect what actually occurred if we maintain final matches that are best of 5. In reality, I'd like to see a return to the best of 3 finals again to reflect what happens at the higher levels of competition in volleyball, including OFSAA. This would also allow for a simple one day schedule to work and cut down on costs for facilities, etc. The total 8 team tournament format (4 senior teams and 4 junior teams) should become standard now at all levels of NOSSA volleyball ("A" "AA" & "AAA") and thus a standard one day schedule could easily be adopted.
